Dame Judi Dench Awarded Freedom Of The City

OSCAR winner Dame Judi Dench was awarded the Freedom of the City of London on 21st June 2011.

The star, who collected the honour at a ceremony at the Guildhall, said she was "very honoured" to accept the accolade.

Dame Judi said: "I look forward to being able to drive my sheep over London Bridge, and occasionally wearing a sword in public."
