Dodgy cubicles and inadequate lighting are a thing of the past. Today's offices are competing in the looks department for a very good reason: a British survey conducted by Management Today, ICM Research and the developer Stanhope found

that nearly half of workers would relinquish one week's annual leave for a better office.

The study by the Commission for Architecture & the Built Environment and the British Council for Offices has found even simple things such as good lighting and having adequate daylight can reduce absenteeism by 15 per cent and increase productivity by between 2.8 per cent and 20 per cent.
